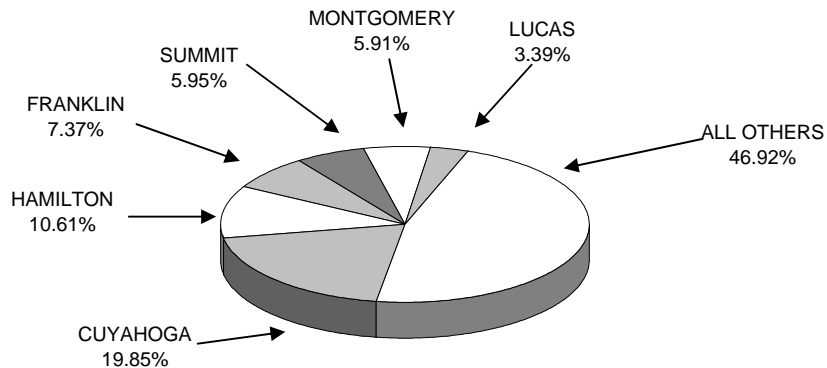

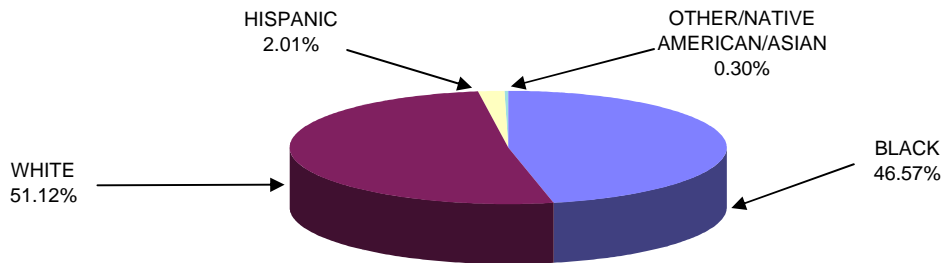
Figure 1. Largest 6 Urban Counties

Figure 3. Distribution of Felony Categories for all Commitments (N =27,431)

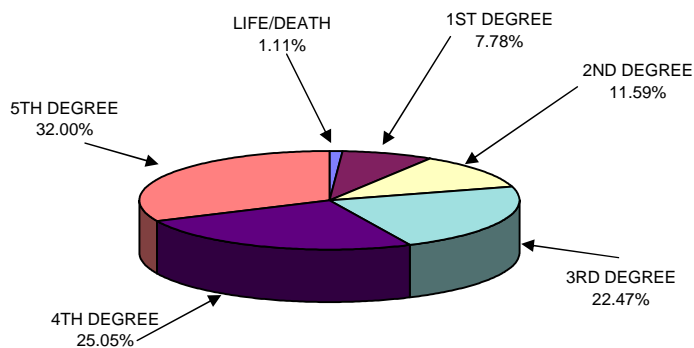
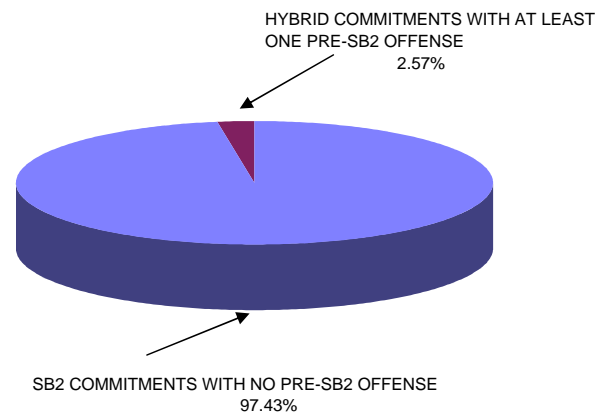


Figure 4. Hybrid Status for all SB2 Commitments (N =27,369)

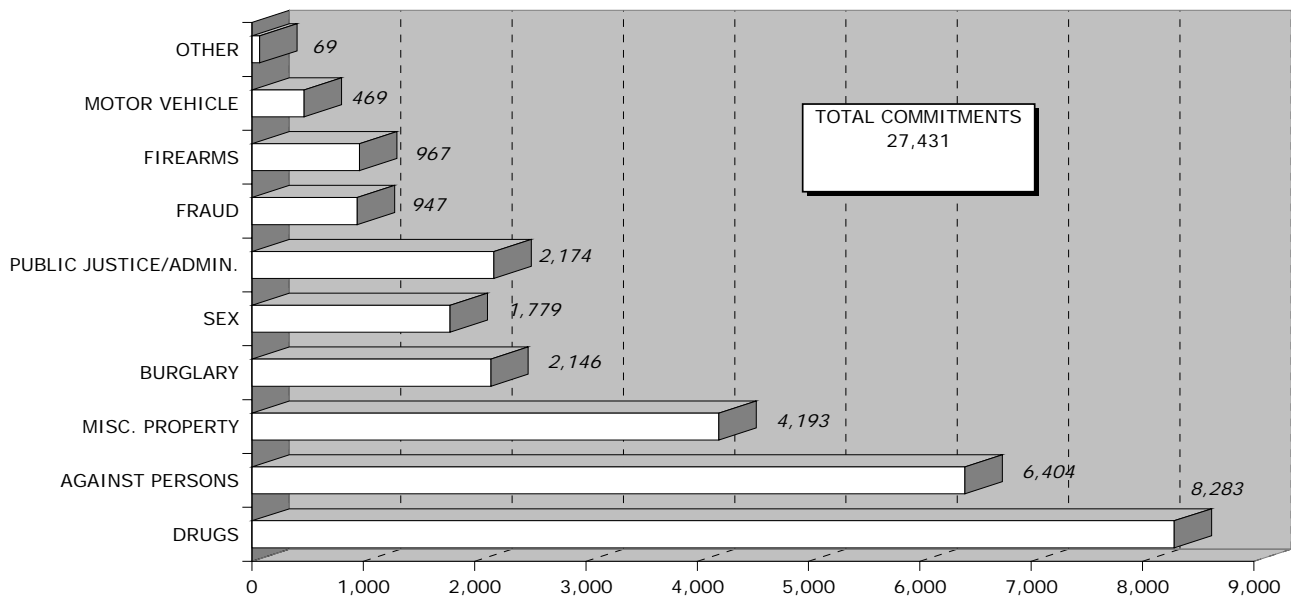
