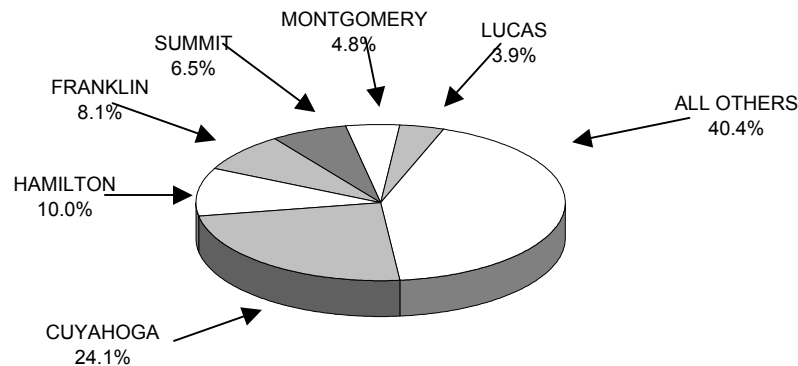

Figure 1. Counties With Largest Proportion of Intake

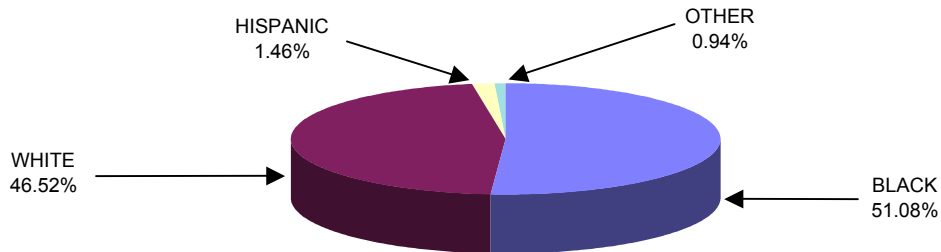

Figure 3. Distribution of Felony Categories for all Commitments (N =22,411)

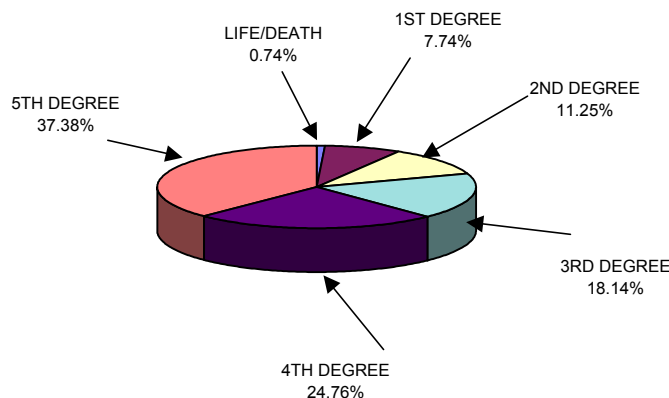
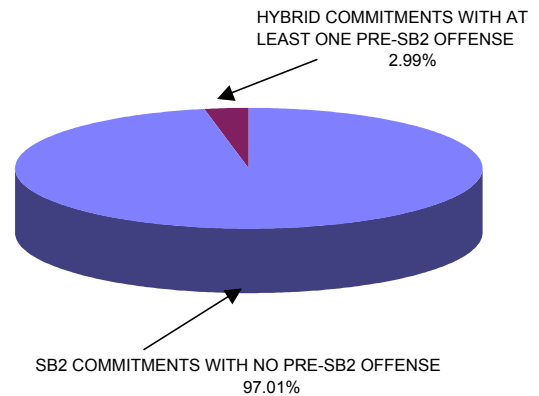


Figure 4. Hybrid Status for all SB2 Commitments (N = 22,136)
