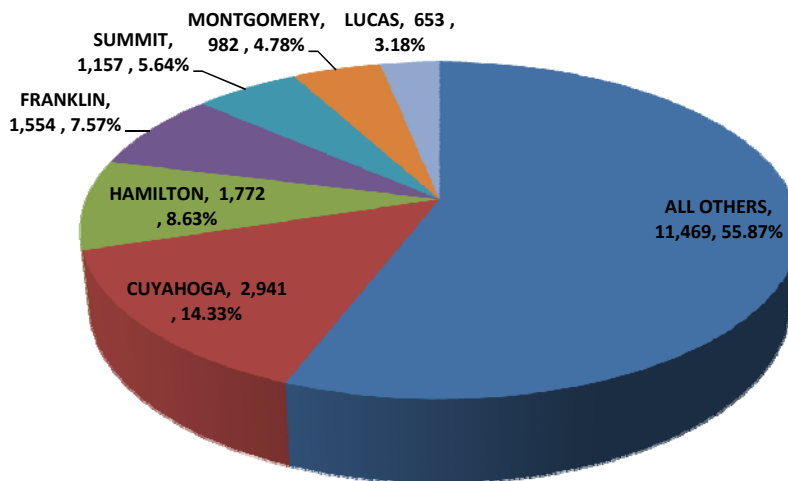

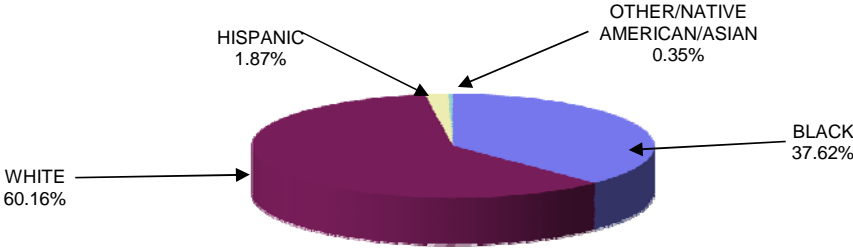

Figure 3. Distribution of Felony Categories for all Commitments (N =20,528)

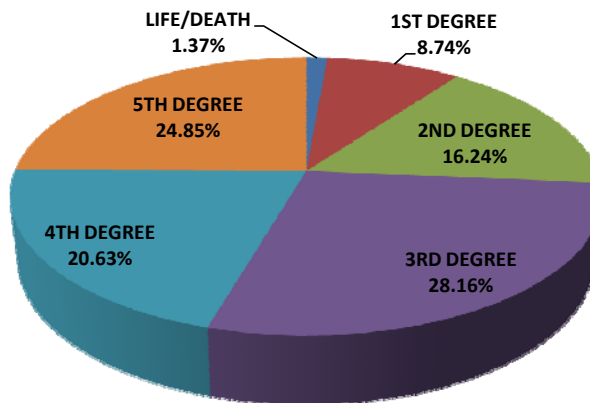
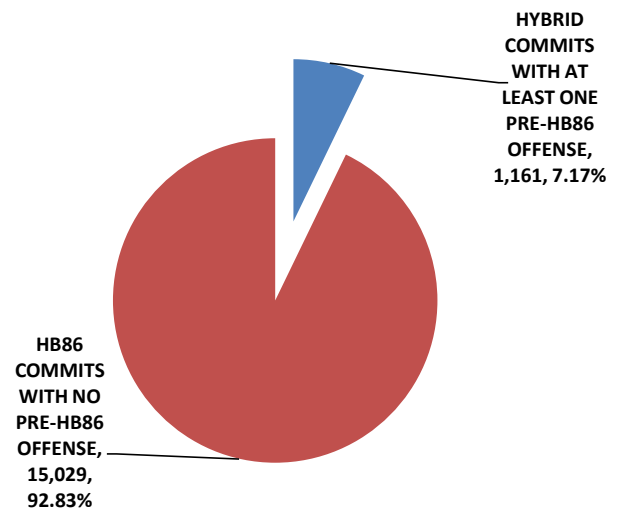


Figure 4. Hybrid Status for all HB 86 Commitments (N = 16,190)

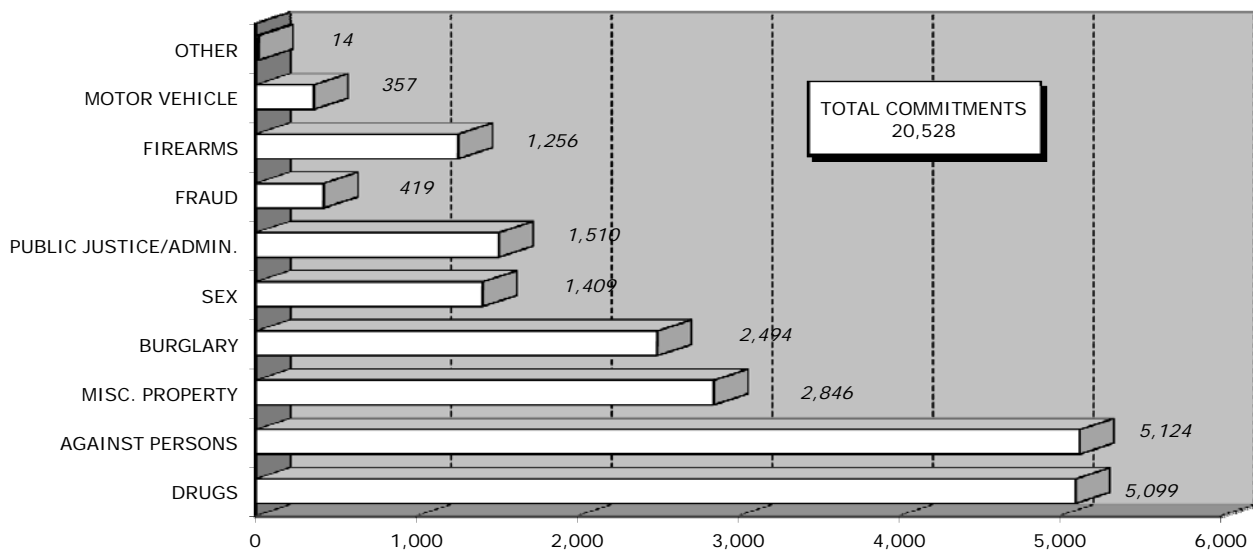
