

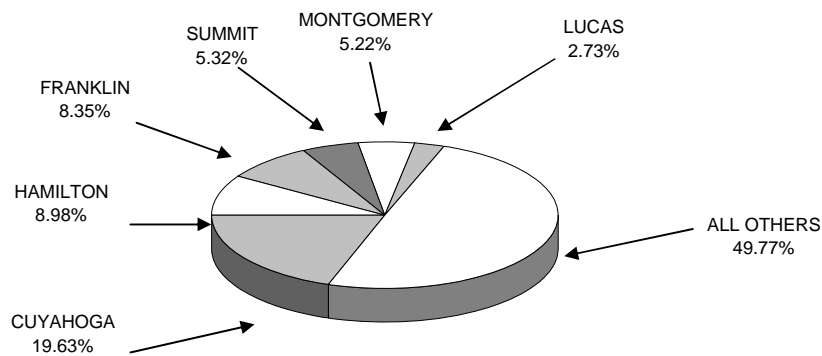

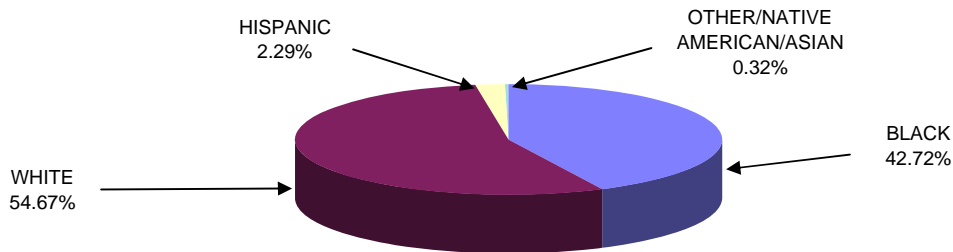

Figure 3. Distribution of Felony Categories for all Commitments (N =23,191)

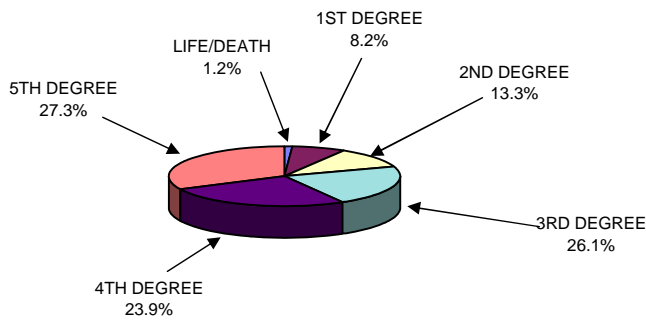
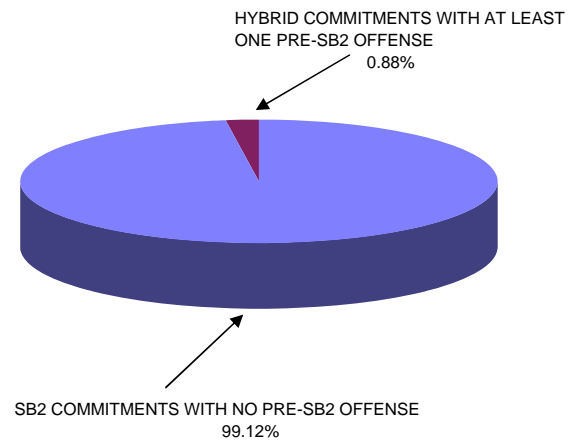


Figure 4. Hybrid Status for all SB2 Commitments (N =23,154)

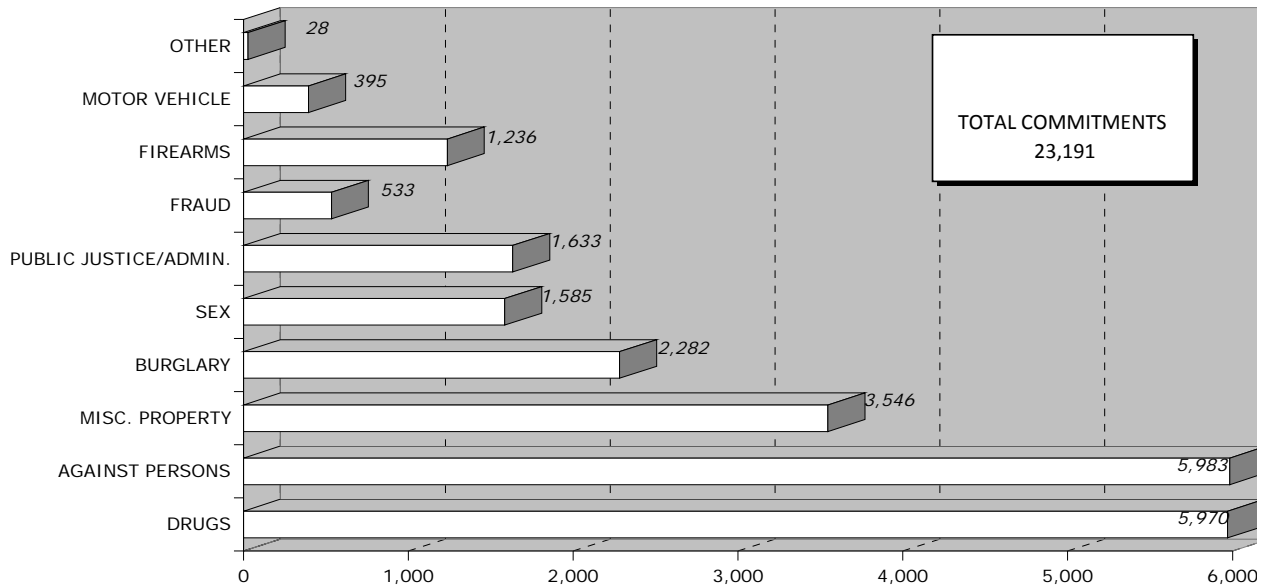
