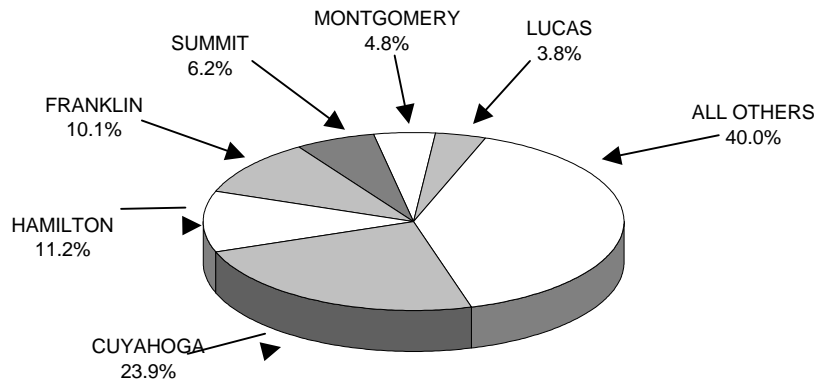

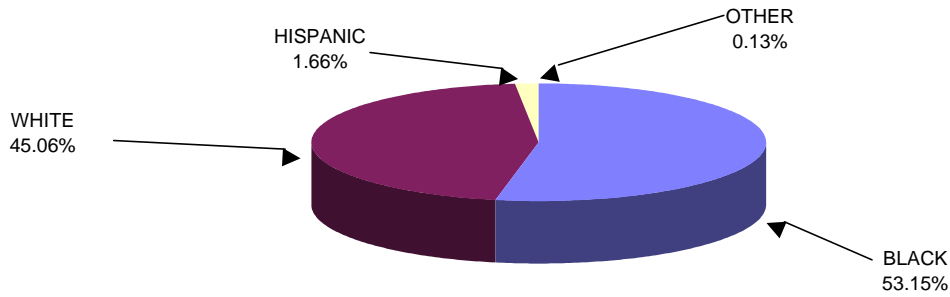
**Figure 1. Counties With Largest Proportion of Intake**

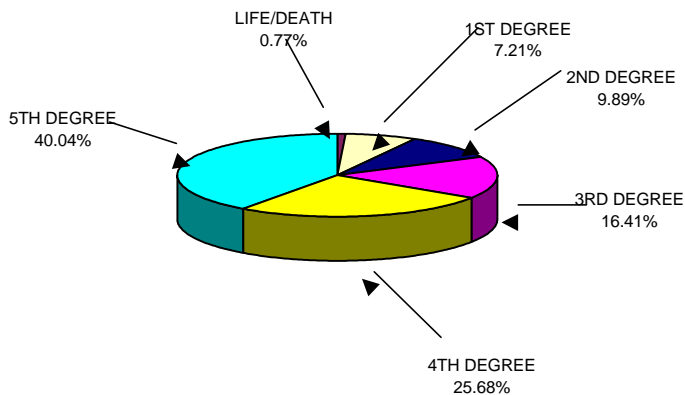

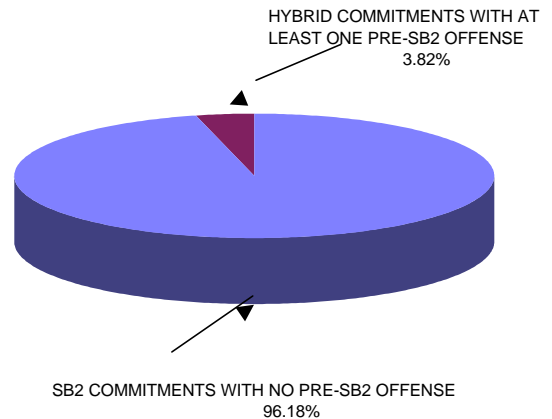
