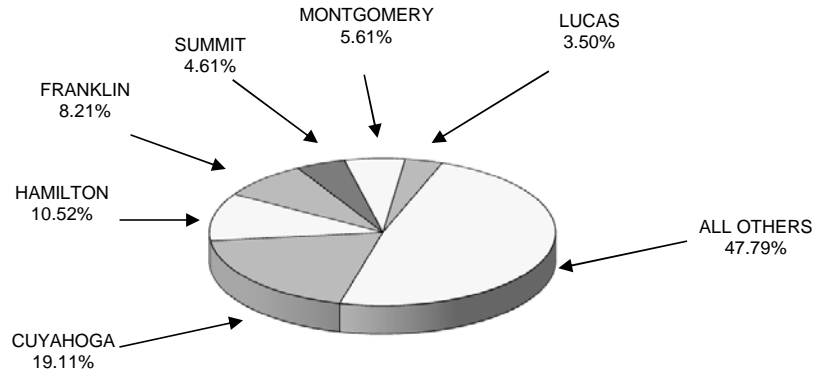

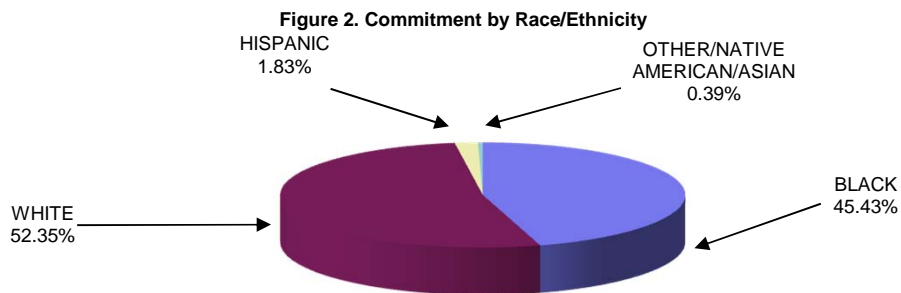

Figure 3. Distribution of Felony Categories for all Commitments (N =27,311)

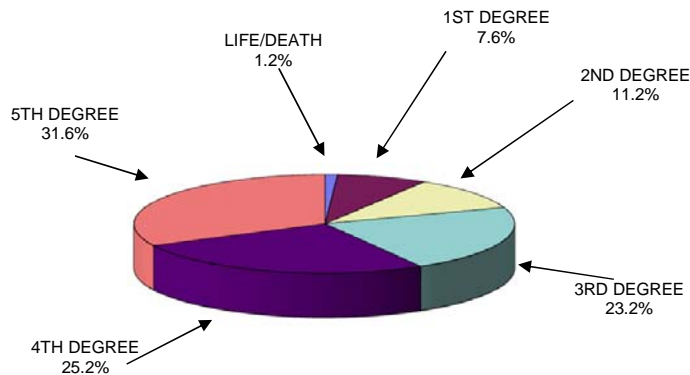
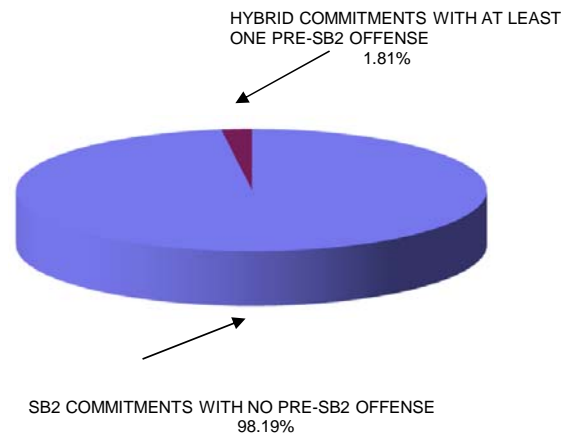


Figure 4. Hybrid Status for all SB2 Commitments (N =27,275)

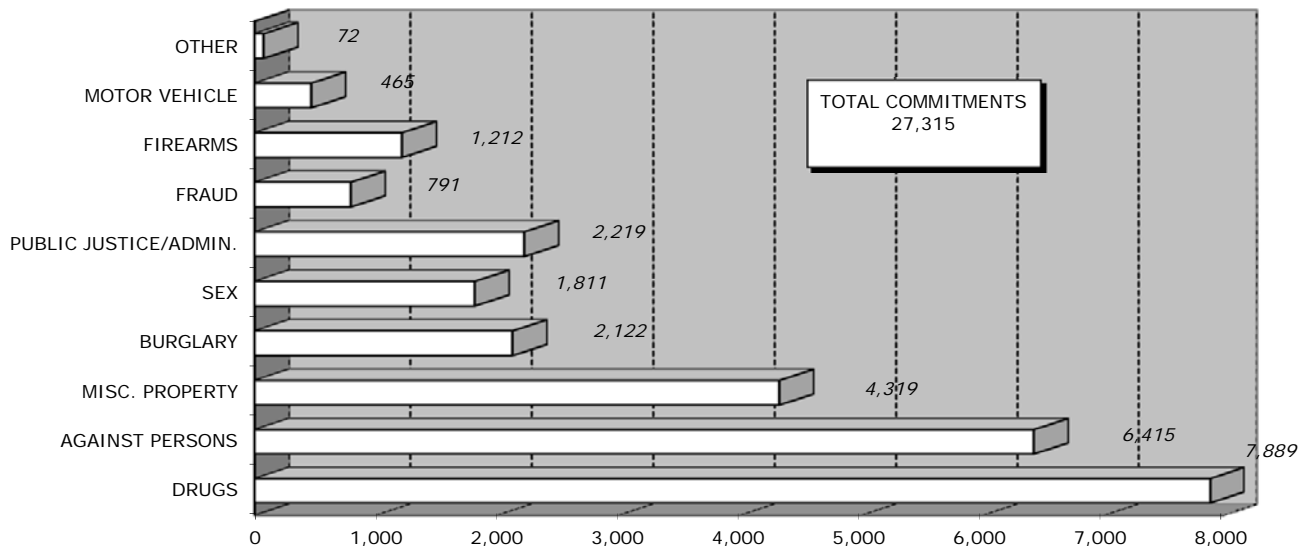
