

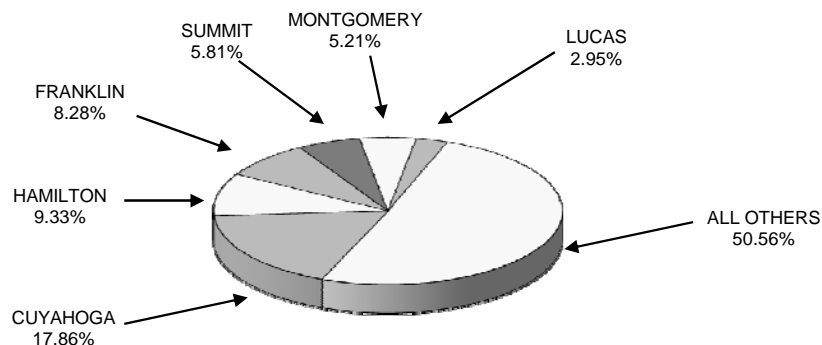

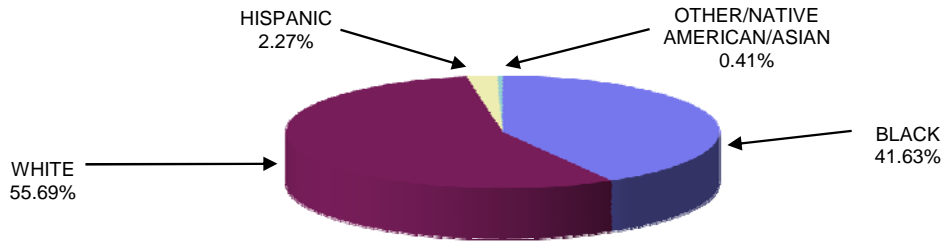
Figure 1. Proportion of Commitments From Largest 6 Counties by Population

Figure 3. Distribution of Felony Categories for all Commitments (N =22,162)

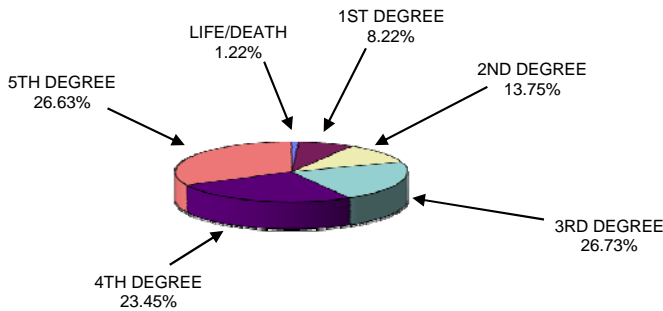
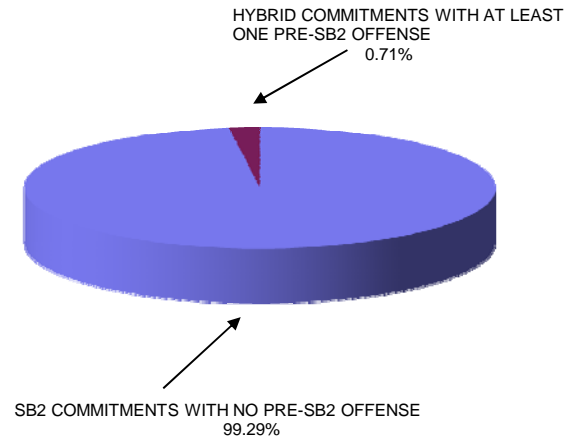


Figure 4. Hybrid Status for all SB2 Commitments (N =22,146)

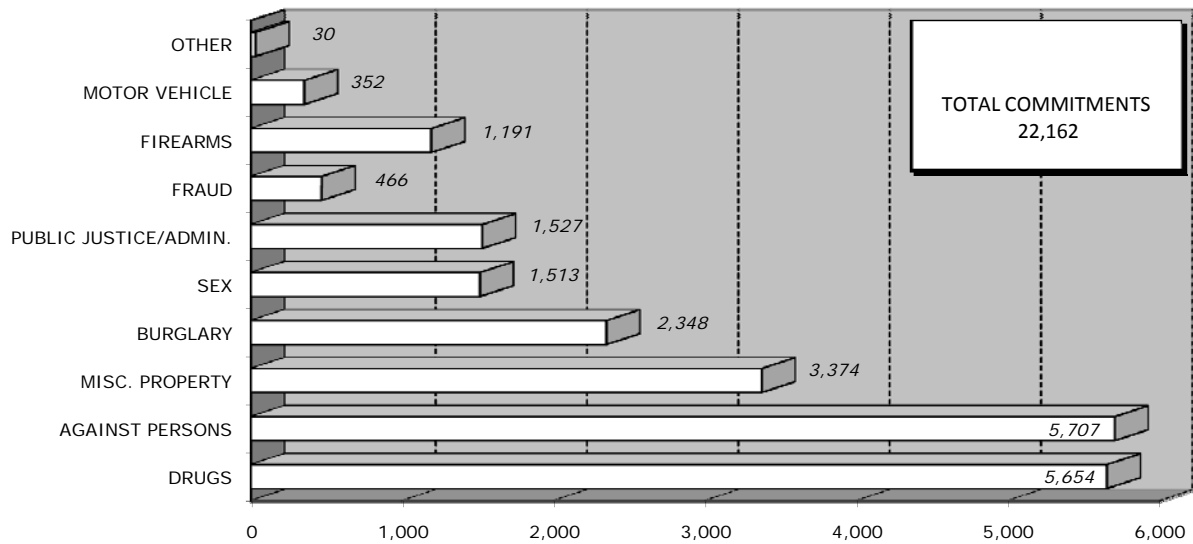
