

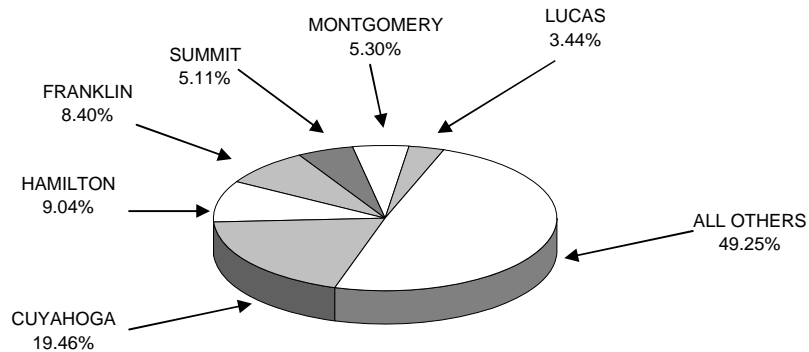

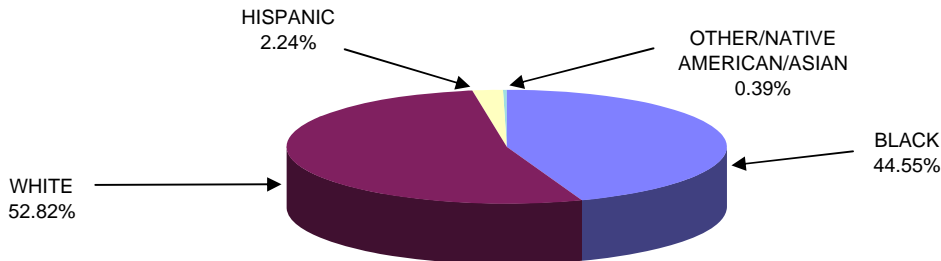
**Figure 1. Largest 6 Urban Counties by Population**

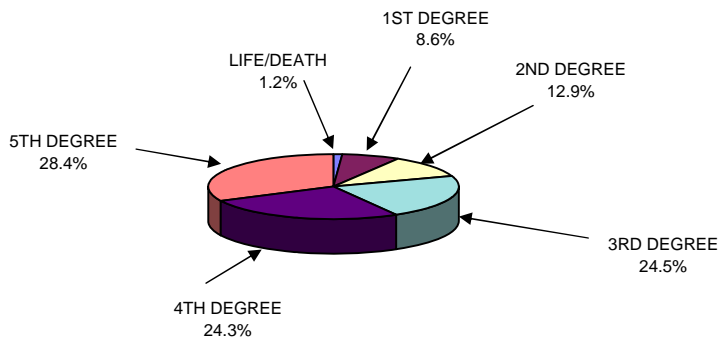

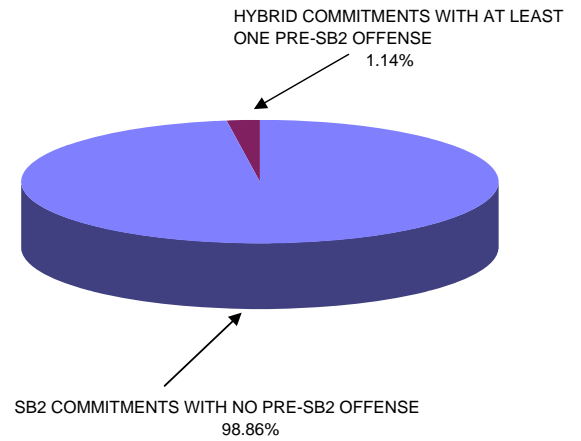

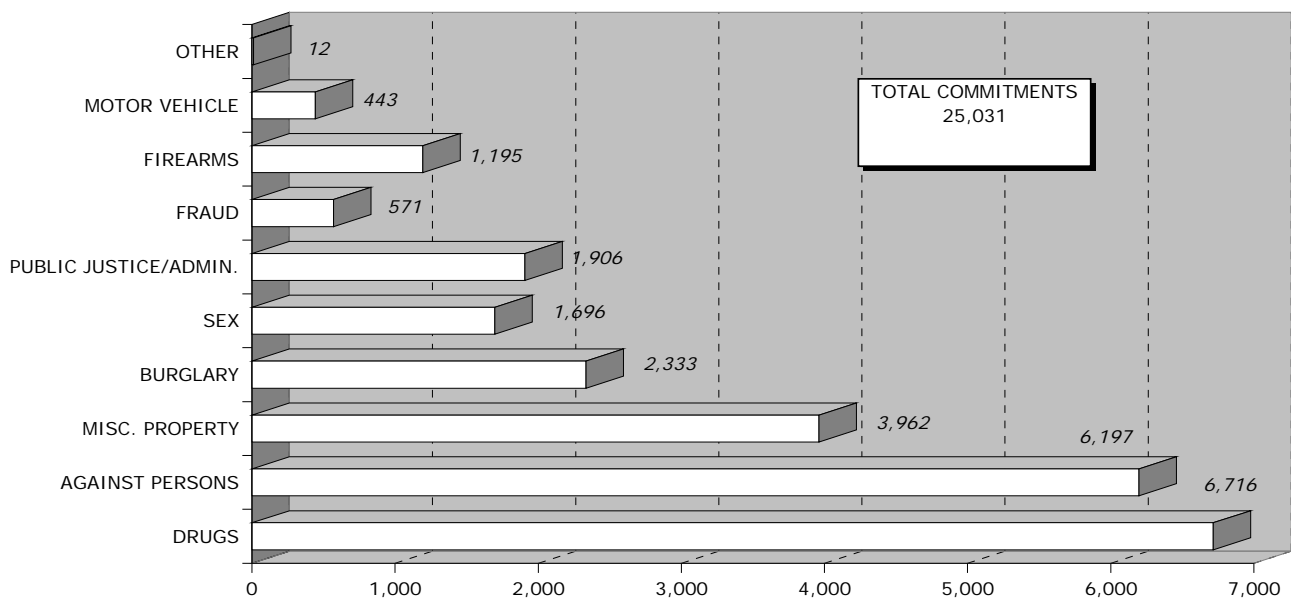
