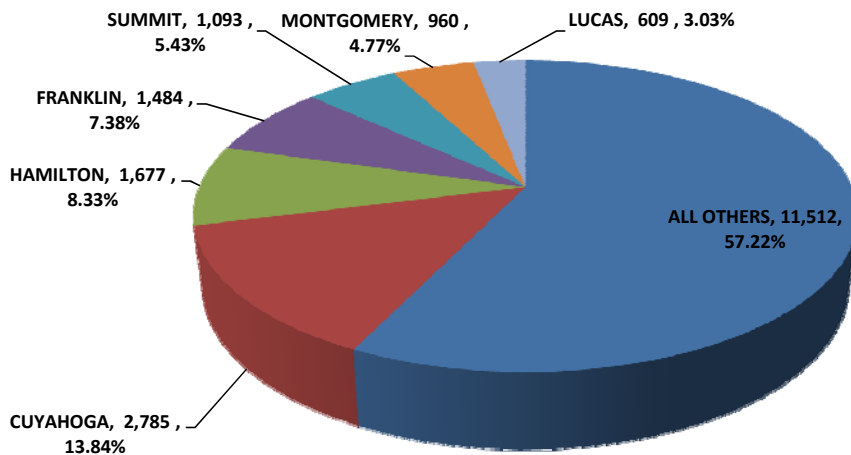

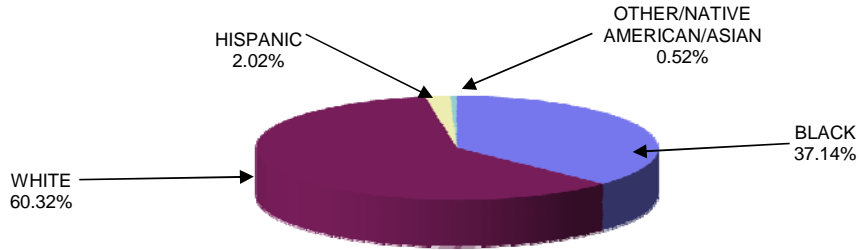
Figure 1. Largest 6 Urban Counties by Population\*

Figure 3. Distribution of Felony Categories for all Commitments (N =20,120)

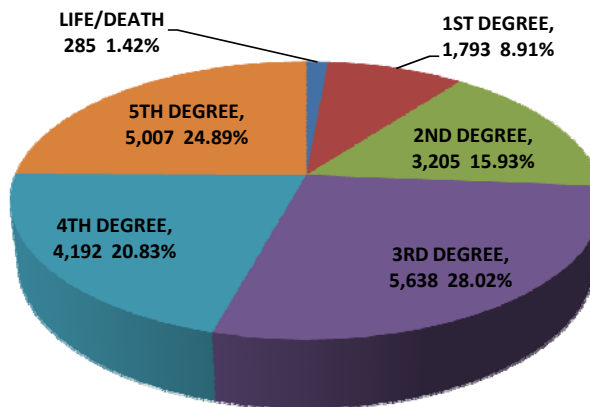
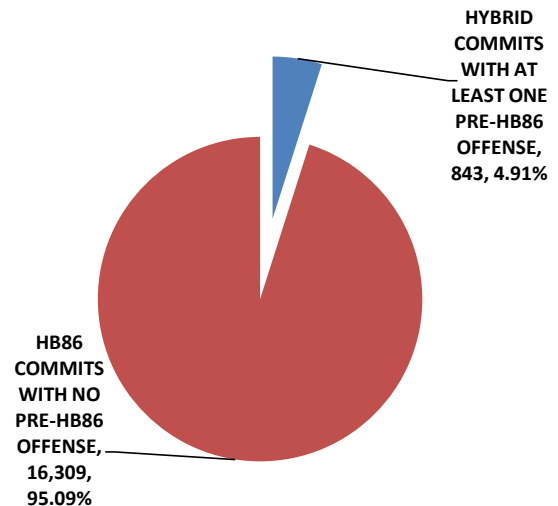


Figure 4. Hybrid Status for all HB 86 Commitments (N = 17,152)

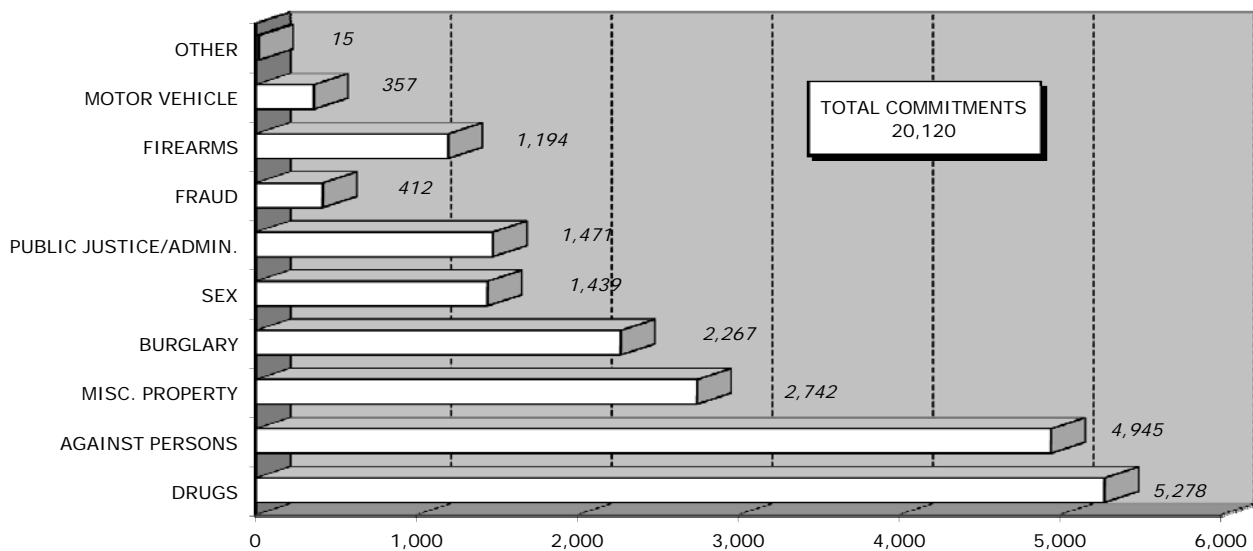
