

OHIO ADULT PAROLE AUTHORITY CENSUS

July 1, 2004

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REPORT OVERVIEW

This report provides a detailed description of the Ohio Adult Parole Authority (APA) active supervision population as of July 1, 2004. The report contains descriptive data on offense and supervision characteristics cross-tabulated by offender's sex, race, and age. Also, it includes detailed breakdowns of APA region & unit locale by offense and supervision types. This is the second APA census in as many years after having not conducted one since 1998. There were many significant changes between the 1998 and 2003 census populations, and a comparison is given in the 2003 APA Census report on the Internet Web site www.drc.state.oh.us/web/research2.html. However, this report does not include a comparison of the 2004 and 1998 APA populations.

There were inconsequential changes between the 2003 and 2004 APA populations, except for an increase of about 2,500 cases under supervision (*see* Table 11).

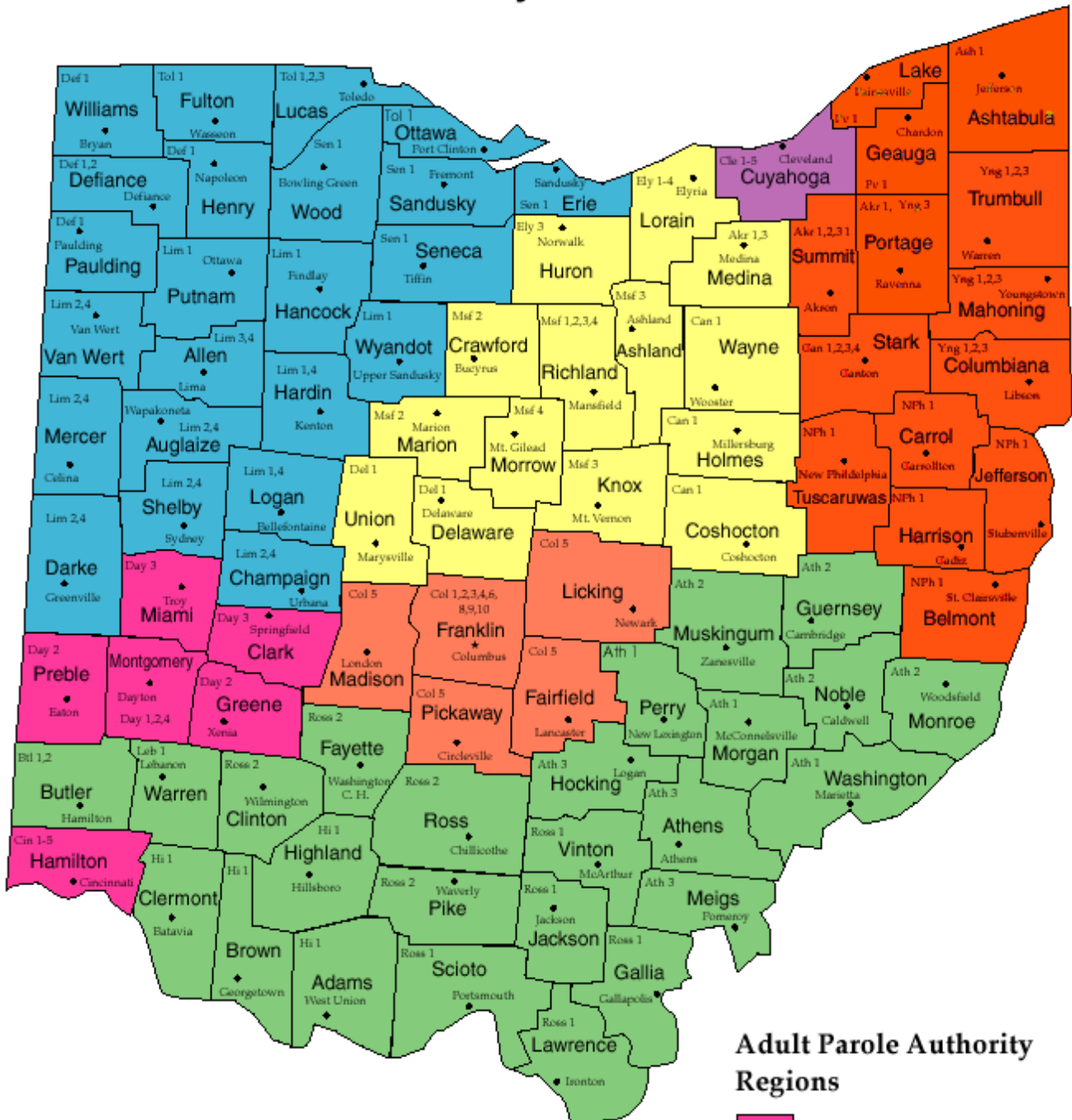
Data source

The data contained in this report were downloaded from an extract of the Community Corrections Information System (CCIS). The data file was extracted on July 7, 2004 so the reported population count of 34,314 closely coincides with the month-end total reported in the June 2004 APA agency report, 34,369 cases. The supervision population described in the report was "snapshot" by selecting only those cases flagged as active on July 7, 2004, excluding cases designated as pending. Those flagged active cases include outgoing interstate compact cases considered active under CCIS business rules. It also includes a smaller number of inactive county probation and community control cases not yet formally designated as closed in CCIS.

Organization of Report

The report presents summary data on sex, age, race, offense type, supervision type, supervision level, APA region & unit locale, and sentencing county. Tables 1-3 provide aggregate data on all APA supervision units combined. Table 1 summarizes age, race, offense, supervision type, and supervision level cross-tabulated by offender's sex and, next, Tables 2 and 3 cross-tabulate supervision type with sex, race, age, offense, and supervision level. Those same variables, in Tables 4-9, are cross-tabulated by APA region & unit locale. Throughout the detailed region and unit tables, the outgoing interstate compact cases, inactive, detainer, and county cases are combined into a single category designated as *Other*, consistent with the reporting structure of the monthly APA agency report; however, those cases are not set apart in Tables 1-3. Next, Table 10 illustrates the rates at which supervised offenders reside in their sentencing counties for the parole and post-release control supervision sub-populations. Finally, Table 11 gives a comparison of the 2003 and 2004 populations on the demographic, offense, and supervision variables. The key findings of the 2004 Ohio APA Census are outlined below in the Executive Summary.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- The total supervision population numbered 34,314. The 4,932 females under supervision constituted 14.4 % of the total population.
- The youngest offender was age 18 and the eldest was 86, giving a range of 68 years. The mean age was 32 and the median age was 31. One-fourth (25%) of the supervision population was between the ages of 18 and 24, while 28% were 40 or older.
- Overall, three-fifths (60%) of the supervision population was white and two-fifths (40%) was nonwhite. Women under supervision were more likely to be white than were the men.
- One-third (32%) of the supervision population had committed a crime against a person (excluding sex offenses) as the most serious commitment offense. If sex offenses are counted, nearly half (47%) of the supervision population had a crime against a person as the most serious commitment offense.
- Post-Release Control (PRC) is the modal form of supervision; one-third (33%) of those under supervision were on PRC. Nearly three out of ten supervisees (29%) were on Community Control, and one-fifth (20%) were on Parole.
- The most serious offense type patterns were significantly different for males and females. While half (51%) of the males under supervision had committed a crime against a person (including sex offenses), only about one-fourth (23%) of the females had committed a crime against a person (including sex offenses) as their most serious commitment offense. Females also had 28% with a property offense and 24% with a drug offense as their most serious commitment offense.
- The distributions of supervision types were strikingly different between males and females, with more than half (52%) of all female supervisees under Community Control. Three-fifths (60%) of the males were on Parole or another post-prison type of release, while two-thirds (67%) of the females were on a probationary type of release. The top three supervision types for males were Post-Release Control (35%), Community Control (26%) and Parole (22%) while, by contrast, the top three for females were Community Control (52%), Post-Release Control (19%), and Compact Probation (10%).

- More than two-fifths (43%) of the population were on a Basic Medium level of supervision and each of about one-fifth were on either Basic Low (23%) or Basic High (20%) supervision. Although the proportion of males (43%) and females (42%) on Basic Medium supervision were comparable, the proportion of females on Basic Low supervision (41%) was twice that than for the males (20%), and the portion of males (23%) on Basic High supervision was nearly three times more than that for females (6%). The number of males and females that were on Intensive supervision was nominal.
- In reviewing the distribution of sex by supervision type, it is evident that the further the stage into the penalty system, the greater the proportion of males, and conversely, the smaller the proportion of females. The Treatment in Lieu supervision type had the largest proportion of females (34.3%) followed by Community Control (25.7%), Compact Probation (23.9), Probation (22.7%), Judicial Release (16.5%), and Transitional Control (12.8%). Post-Release Control (8.3%) and Parole (4.0%) had slight proportions of females.
- Supervision type Parole had the largest proportion of nonwhites (59.9%) followed by Transitional Control (53.3%), Post-Release Control (47.3%), Compact Parole (45.8%), Shock Probation (35.3%), Compact Probation (27.8%), Probation (24.4%), and Community Control (24.0%). Treatment in Lieu accounted for only 11.0 % of nonwhites. It should be noted that the Ohio APA does not supervise Community Control offenders in any of its largest cities, i.e., Cincinnati, Cleveland, or Columbus.
- Supervision type Judicial Release had the largest proportion of supervisees age 24 and under (35.2%), followed by Treatment in Lieu (33.9%), Community Control (32.9%), Post-Release Control (30.2%), Probation (27.0%) and Compact Probation (25.9%). Only 1.1% of the parolees were age 24 and under. Generally, pre-prison penalties had younger offenders.
- Supervisees on Parole were older, with a median age of 38, and conversely, Judicial Release and Post-Release Control were comprised of younger offenders with median ages of 27 and 29, respectively. The median age of Probation and Community Control was 30.
- Three-quarters (75.6 %) of the in-state offenders under Parole or Post-Release Control supervision on July 1, 2004, were living in the same county through which they were sentenced. Generally, the more rural regions and counties were below the statewide rate. The Chillicothe, Mansfield, and Lima regions had 57.9%, 62.9%, and 70.6%, respectively, for rates of offenders living in the same county in which they were sentenced. The lowest rate of all counties statewide was Geauga County, with a rate of 10.7 %.
