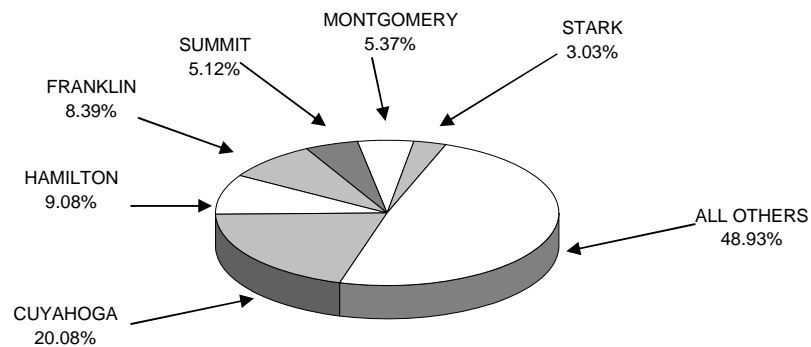

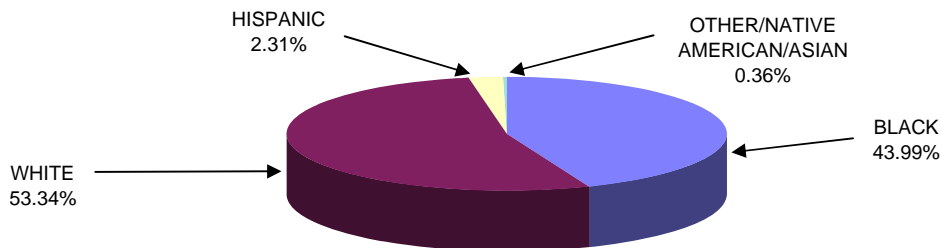
Figure 1. Largest 6 Urban Counties by Population

Figure 3. Distribution of Felony Categories for all Commitments (N =24,021)

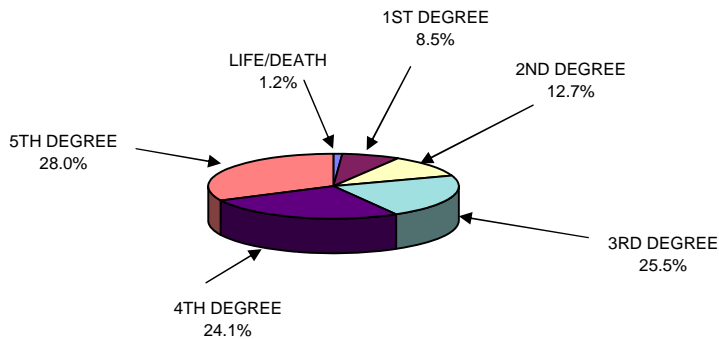
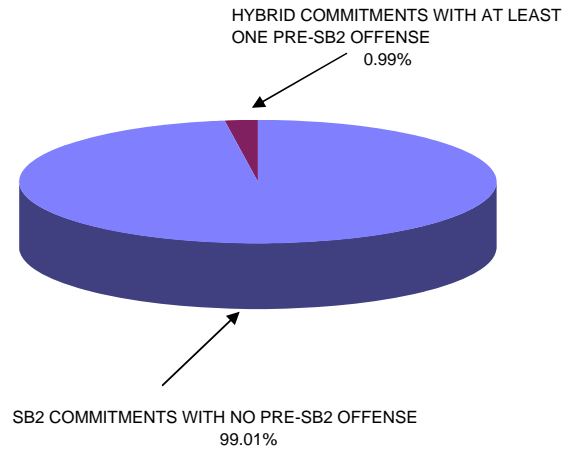


Figure 4. Hybrid Status for all SB2 Commitments (N =23,982)

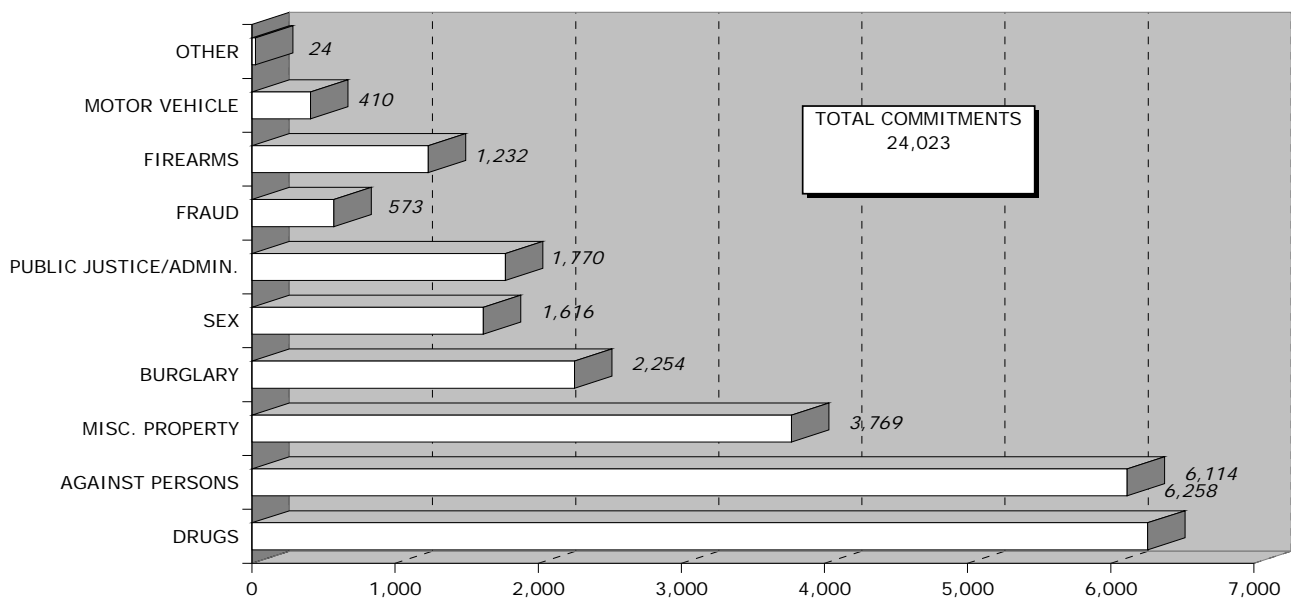
