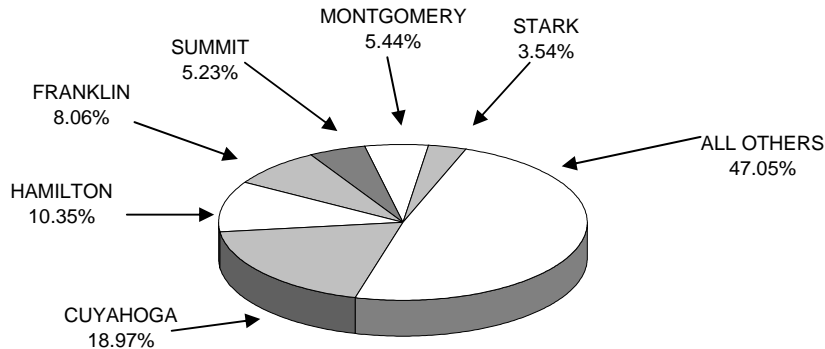

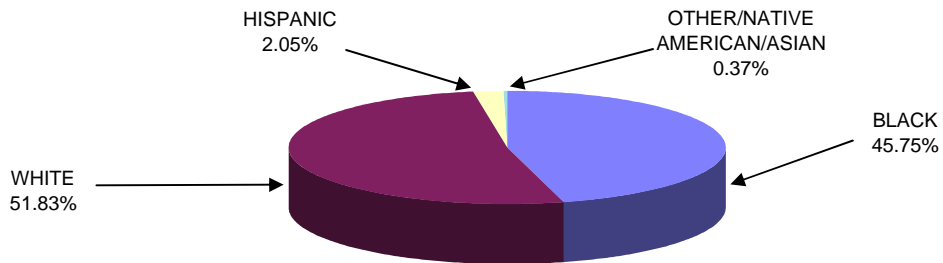
Figure 1. Largest 6 Committing Counties

Figure 3. Distribution of Felony Categories for all Commitments (N =28,178)

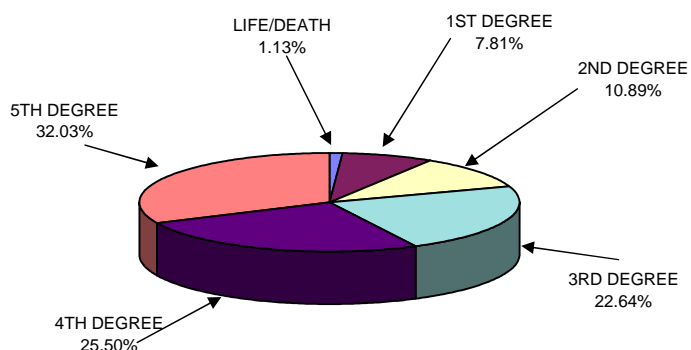
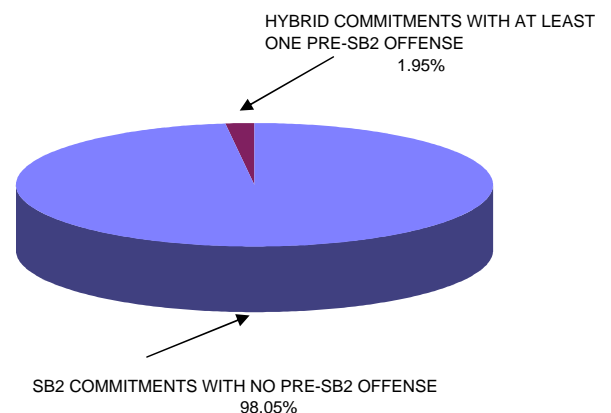


Figure 4. Hybrid Status for all SB2 Commitments (N =28,130)

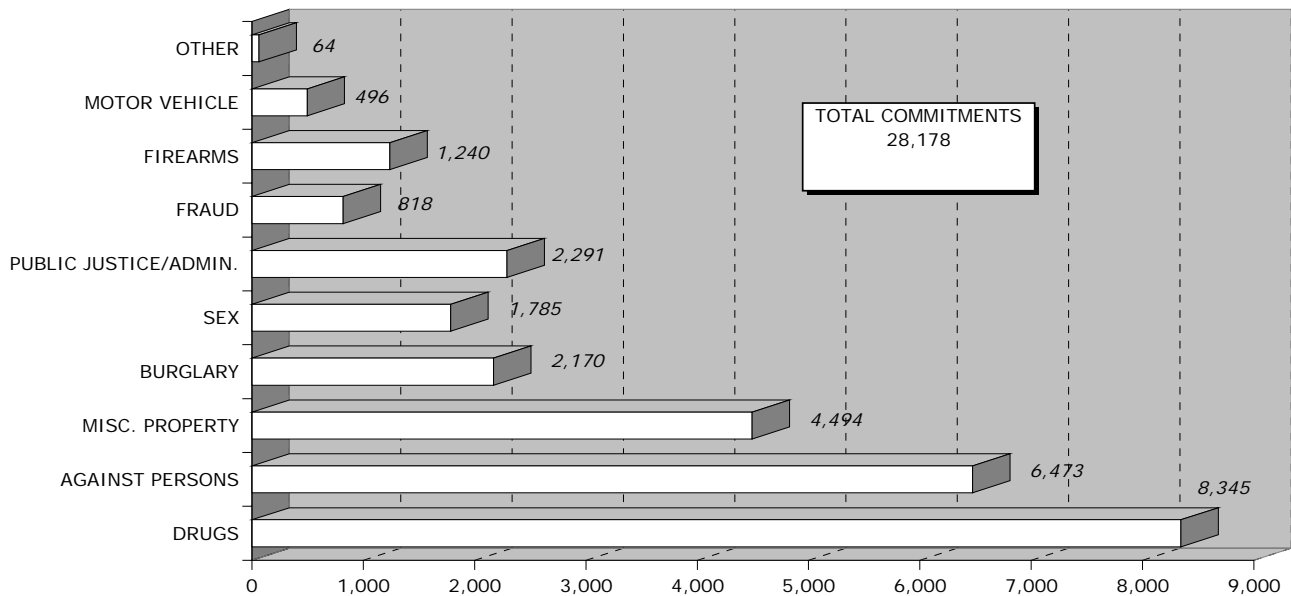
