Dear Sheriff Lucas:


The Bureau of Adult Detention has received the Plans of Action and additional corrective material you submitted through the Ohio Jail Management System (OHJMS) in response to the annual inspection of the Belmont County Jail on October 7th, 2019. We appreciate your efforts in attempting to maintain compliance with the Minimum-Standards for Jails in Ohio.

Inspector David Hicks and I have reviewed the provided material. The jail remains out of compliance with standards: 5120: 1-8-04(A)(4)(Important); -04(B)(Important); and -09(N)(Essential).

The Plans of Action submitted for the deficiencies appear to identify the proposed means for bringing the Belmont County Jail back into compliance with these Standards. We encourage you to implement these changes as soon as possible. The Belmont County Jail will remain a **Status Jail** until the next inspection or until the remaining corrective action has been completed.


