

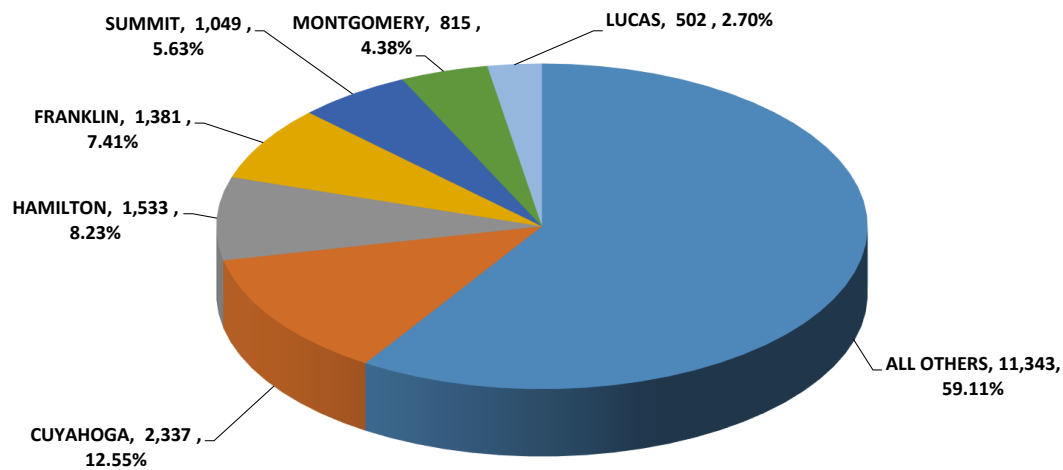

Figure 1. Largest 6 Urban Counties by Population\* (not DRC)

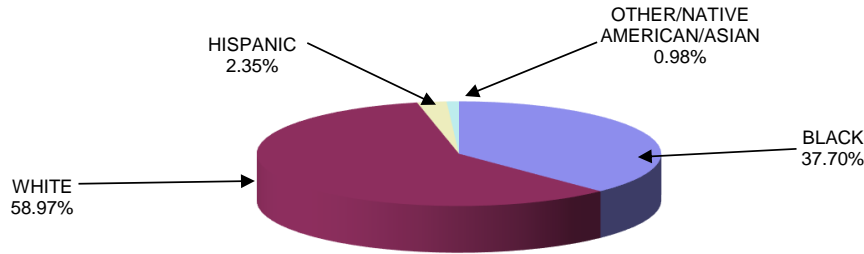

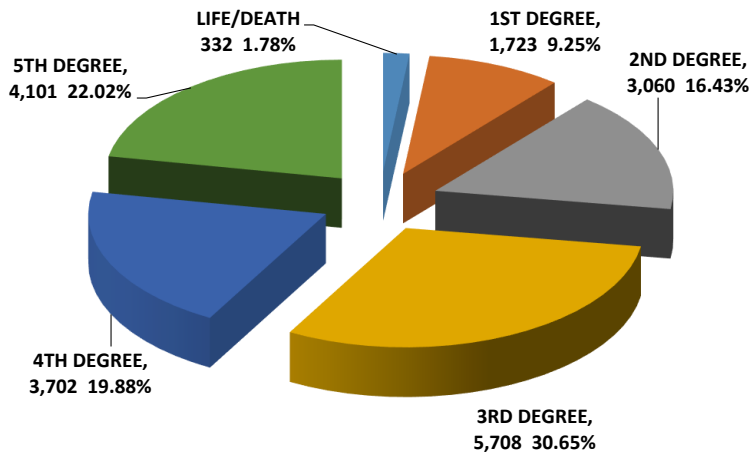

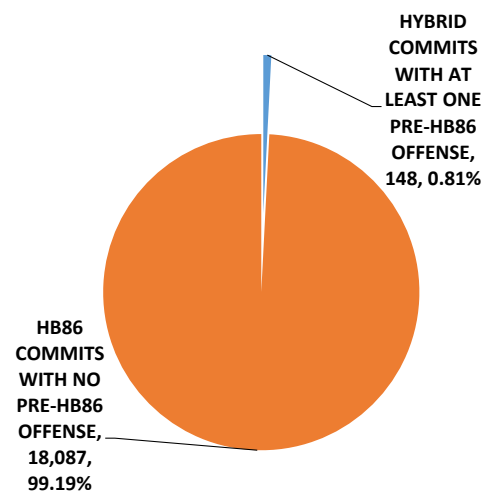

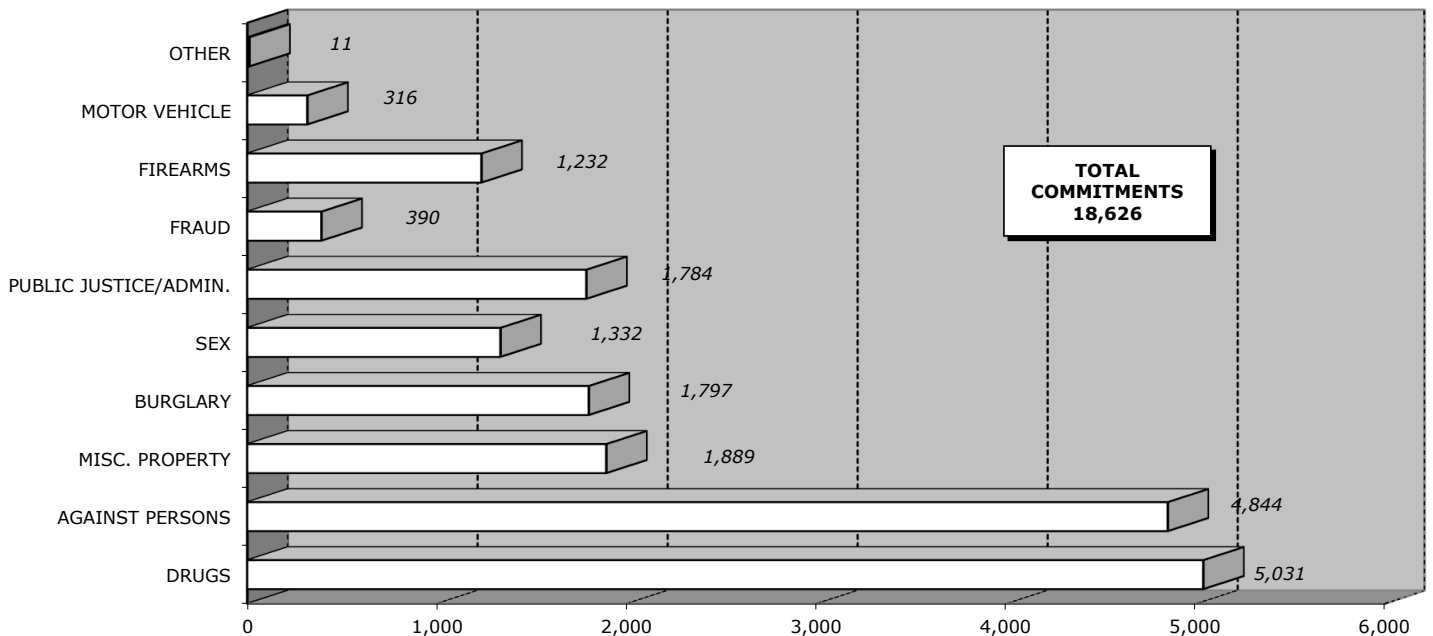
