Subject: MACI specific Inmate Visitor Information

- All visitors are required to follow the “General Visiting Instructions” from Visiting policy 76-VIS-01.
- Camouflage clothing of any kind is not permitted at MACI.
- All items from visitor’s pockets MUST be emptied out for inspection and pockets turned inside out if possible. All items must be inspected by the Entry Officer, regardless of if it will set off the metal detector or not.
- No cash, coins, debit cards, wallets, etc. are permitted into the compound.
- All inmate visitors must clear the metal detector.
- Visitors with a joint replacement or a pacemaker must present a medical card/documentation, at which time the trans-frisker will be used. The medical card/documentation will be kept on file for future visits.

Inmate visitors must adhere to the following jewelry restrictions:

- Earrings must be basic stud or hoop style. If the earring is larger than 1 inch in size, then the earrings must be removed to be inspected by the Entry Officer.
- No necklaces of any kind are permitted entry.
- No bracelets of any kind are permitted entry, except silicone style wrist bands. These must be removed to be inspected by the Entry Officer.
- No watches of any kind are permitted entry.
- No fit bits of any kind are permitted entry.
- It is the Entry Officer’s discretion if a hair clip will need removed for inspection. If requested by staff, it must be removed for inspection before being permitted entry.
- The only rings permitted entry are wedding rings/bands. No other rings are permitted entry.

Any item that is not permitted in the visiting room (examples: unapproved jewelry, unapproved key chains, money, etc.), must be taken out to the vehicle or placed in the lockers available. Staff are never permitted to hold any items for an inmate visitor until the completion of their visit.
