# Victim Notification:

## Ohio Revised Code 2930.16C

- Upon the victim's request made at any time before the particular notice would be due, the custodial agency of a defendant or alleged juvenile offender shall give the victim any of the following notices that is applicable:
- At least three weeks before the adult parole authority recommends a pardon or commutation of sentence for the defendant or at least three weeks prior to a hearing before the adult parole authority regarding a grant of parole to the defendant, notice of the victim's right to submit a statement regarding the impact of the defendant's release in accordance with section [2967.12](#) of the Revised Code and, if applicable, of the victim's right to appear at a full board hearing of the parole board to give testimony as authorized by section [5149.101](#) of the Revised Code

# Victim Coordinators

In June 1996, DRC first appointed Victim Coordinators to specialize in victims' issues at local worksites and assist the Office of Victim Services. Each institution and APA Office appoints at least one staff member to serve as the Victim Coordinator in addition to his/her regular duties. Victim Coordinators are tasked with responding to victim issues through support, intervention and education in partnership with the Office of Victim Services, while maintaining their normal job responsibilities. Their minimum job responsibilities include: attending 3 coordinator meetings, participating in 16 hours of victim-related training, serving as the in-service trainer for victim services, assisting with visitation issues involving victims, and as a responder for PREA. DRC currently has 100 trained victim coordinators.

# Ohio Council on Victims' Justice

- The Ohio Council on Victims' Justice plays an active role in the Department's efforts to improve victim services. They provide input and make suggestions for operational changes that impact victims and serve as liaisons between the Department and the constituents of Council members.
- This Council also assists the Department in the development of victim services and departmental practices that are victim-sensitive by critiquing relevant policies, reviewing and commenting upon the agency's goals and objectives, and developing recommendations for the implementation of needed services.
- Council members aid in the victim education process by playing a leadership role in professional associations discussing victim issues and being an information source for the public on correctional victim issues. Members of this council represent victims, victim service coalitions, law enforcement, prosecutors, judges, and other stakeholders.

# Personal Responsibility Of Violence Elimination (P.R.O.V.E.)

The P.R.O.V.E. program is an institution-based batterer's intervention program for those offenders convicted of domestic violence offense behavior. The program is currently implemented in 8 correctional institutions and has received two Excel Awards since its onset in 2005.

# Overview of Victim Awareness

The Victim Awareness Program began in January 1995 at London Correctional Institution and is now implemented in DRC institutions and Adult Parole Authority regions throughout the state. In 2009, the Victim Awareness Facilitator training was completed on a newly revised curriculum, including a female offender specific curriculum. Statewide, we have a total of **113** facilitators within the correctional institutions and **63** facilitators in communities throughout Ohio to include Adult Parole Authority regions, Halfway Houses, Community Based Correctional Facilities and probation Departments. Many of our community programs have established partnerships with community agencies to collaborate staffing and resources to ensure the continued success of Victim Awareness to include UMADAOP's throughout Ohio, Intensive Probation and CIRV.

# Overview of Victim Awareness

In 2010, the Office of Victim Services staff conducted 50 program site visits to institutions and community programs.

The number of offenders who started and completed the Victim Awareness program in 2010 is calculated using the mandatory paperwork that is submitted to OVS which includes pre/post tests and the program completion report.

- 113 Institution facilitators
- 63 Community facilitators
  - 1654 offenders started the program in 2010
  - 1095 offenders completed the program in 2010
  - Resulting in a 66% completion rate

# Overview of Victim Offender Dialogue

The Office of Victim Services created the Victim Offender Dialogue Program in May 1997, at the request of crime victims. Victim Offender Dialogue is a process in which the victim of a crime and the offender who committed the offense meet face to face. The focus is on the harm done to the victim and the offender's responsibility in the reparation of that harm. Historically, victims of crime have been left out of the justice process and were not afforded the same rights as offenders in their cases and the dialogue process provides a meaningful solution for some crime survivors. There are many reasons a victim might have interest in meeting with the person who harmed them. We currently have 42 trained dialogue facilitators and have completed approximately 100 dialogue cases with 25 more pending.

# Current Research

The **Victim-Offender Dialogue Program** is currently undergoing research through the Ohio State University College of Social Work. As a follow-up to Dr. Ian Borton's quantitative analysis of communication patterns between victims and offenders, doctoral student Janet Melcher's research goal is a qualitative study to add to the understanding about what is most helpful to people who have lost a loved one as a result of an unlawful act and to quantify the lasting effects of participation in Victim-Offender Dialogue.

The **Victim Awareness Program** is currently in the final stages of evaluation with Monica Ellis, Social Science Research Specialist at the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services, who serves as the principal researcher working with the Office of Victim Services for the study. The research will prove important to the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction because it will provide data that will demonstrate the effects of the newly revised curriculum being implemented throughout Ohio correctional institutions and Adult Parole Authority regions.

# Workplace Violence

The Office of Victim Services oversees the DRC Workplace Violence policy # 31-SEM-08. It is the policy of the Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction to enforce “zero tolerance” for violence in the workplace. Threats or acts of violence among persons employed by DRC, independent contractors and volunteers providing a service to the Department, and visitors to any Department location will not be tolerated. Any individual violating this policy will be subject to disciplinary action and may be subject to legal action. DRC treats all victims of workplace violence and workplace domestic violence with respect while making every effort to protect victims of these issues by offering all available security measures.

Further, all DRC work sites shall cultivate an environment of openness and support so that victims of workplace violence and workplace domestic violence can report incidents without being embarrassed, threatened by loss of job, or afraid of not being taken seriously. The Workplace Violence Liaison/designee shall notify the Office of Victim Services of all incidents that are workplace violence and workplace domestic violence no later than the business day following the initial incident by providing a copy of the initial incident report.

# Workplace Violence Liaisons

Each facility and APA region shall appoint one staff member to serve as the Workplace Violence Liaison, in addition to his/her regular duties, as determined by the Managing Officer/designee. The Workplace Violence Liaison shall be an exempt employee and shall not be the Victim Coordinator. The Workplace Violence Liaison shall attend the specialized 8-hour training for Workplace Violence Liaisons. The Office of Victim Services serves as the Workplace Violence Liaison for central office.

# Workplace Violence Liaisons

The Workplace Violence Liaison is responsible for the following:

- Serve as a liaison between the victim and perpetrator of workplace violence/workplace domestic and administration.
- Participate in discussions with the affected department about the handling of workplace violence/workplace domestic violence issues.
- Maintain a database of all actual or potential incidents of workplace violence that are reported at their facility/APA region and their current status.
- Report all actual or potential incidents of workplace violence/workplace domestic violence to the Office of Victim Services by providing a copy of the initial incident report no later than the business day following the incident.
- Inform the Office of Victim Services upon completion of any investigation and/or discipline by providing a copy of the paperwork.
- Work closely with the Victim Coordinator to provide support for the victim of workplace violence/workplace domestic violence.
- Provide the victim with a list of resources in the event they may need additional assistance.

# Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA)

On December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010, OVS trained 56 additional staff to respond as 'victim support persons' per policy 79-ISA-01 and 79-ISA-02. These individuals work with inmates who allege being sexually assaulted while in our custody to provide information and support throughout the investigation and possible prosecution of their cases. They also participate in the institutions SAC (Sexual Assault Committee) meetings to represent victims' issues.
