

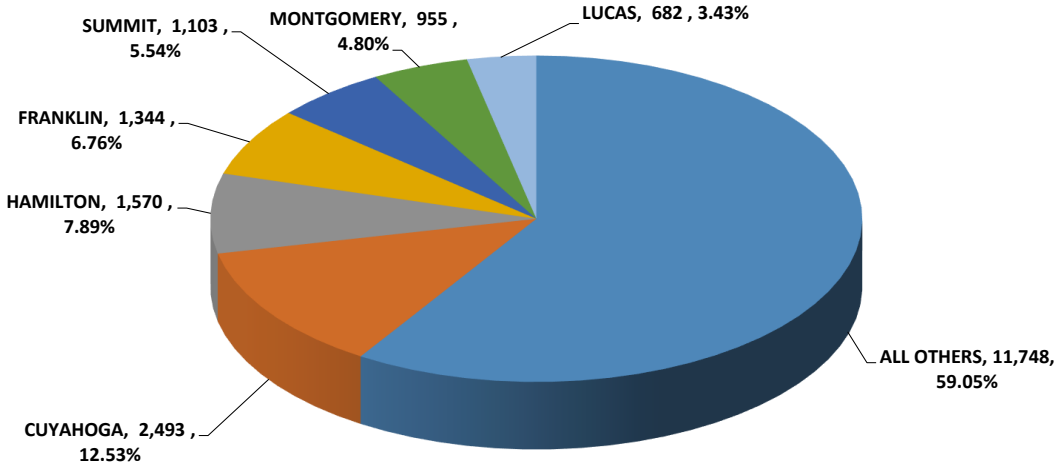

Figure 1. Largest 6 Urban Counties by Population\* (not DRC)

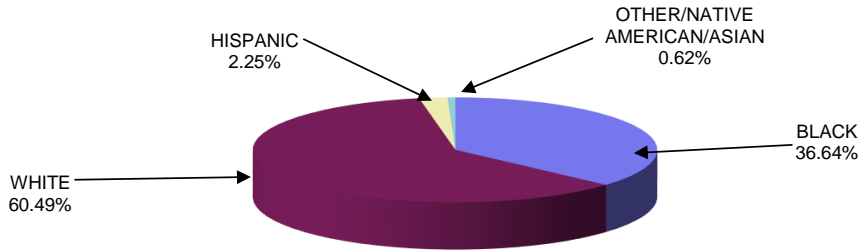

Figure 3. Distribution of Felony Categories for all Commitments (N =19,895)

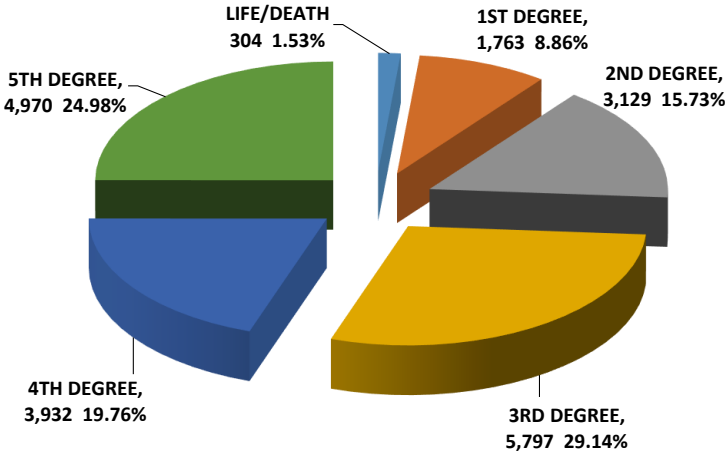
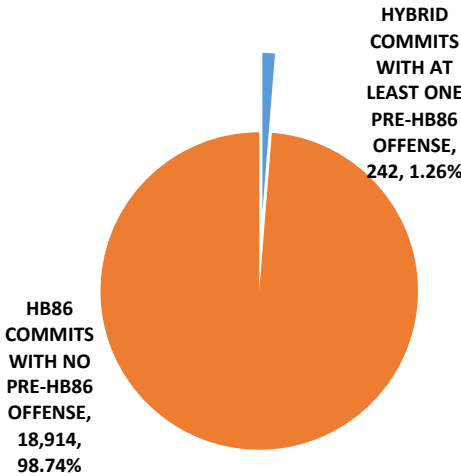


Figure 4. Hybrid Status for all HB 86 Commitments (N = 19,156)

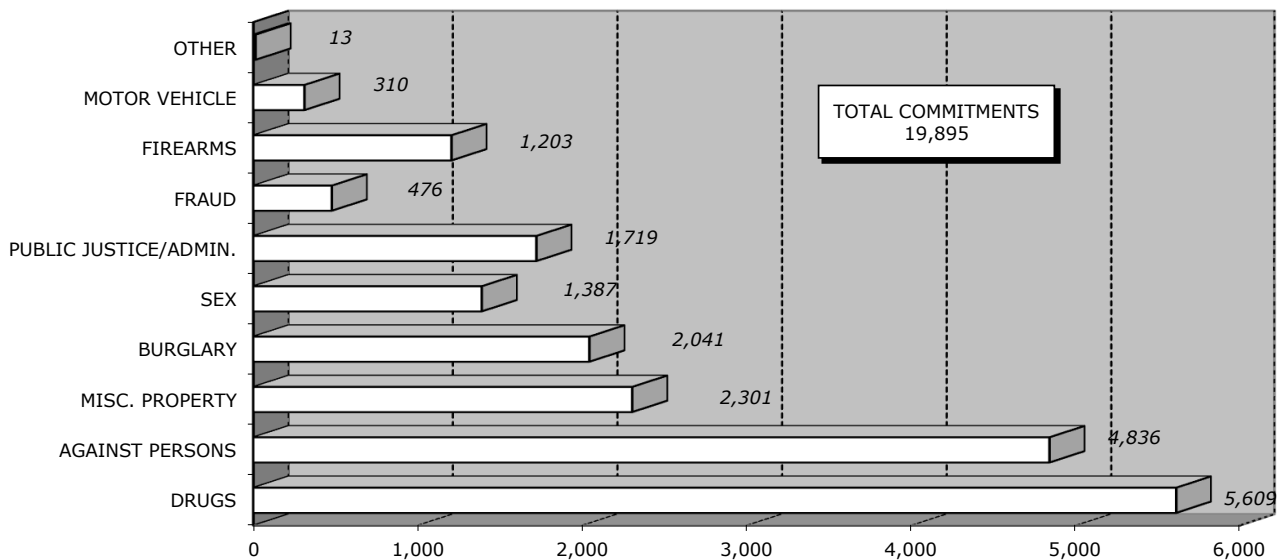
