

VISITOR DRESS CODE

All clothing worn when processed through the entry building of the institution must be worn throughout the visit, with the exception of appropriate outerwear such as a coat and gloves. Undergarments must be worn (i.e., bra, slip and underwear). No additional clothing is permitted to be carried into the facility.

You may be denied entrance into visitation for inappropriate attire.

Clothing considered to be inappropriate includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- Clothing with gang insignias, obscene gestures and/or language
- See-through clothing of any kind
- Wrap around skirts, dresses or break away type pants
- Blouses with the shoulders cut out or exposed
- Tops or dresses that expose the midriff, have open backs or open sides
- Clothing that has holes or rips
- Spaghetti straps, tank tops or muscle shirts
- Form fitting clothing
- Spandex pants, yoga pants, low cut pants or stretch pants
- Low cut clothing exposing any cleavage
- Skirts/dresses that are above the mid-knee
- Shorts that are above the knee
- Bare midriff clothing
- Skirts, dresses, shorts, skirts or culottes with the hem or slit exposing the knee
- Any other clothing deemed inappropriate by the supervisor

Shoes must be always worn as well as appropriate undergarments (i.e., bra, slip, underwear).
